

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Manatee County is undergoing improvements that include construction associated with the replacement of both sewer and water lines, as well as modifications to existing lift station piping and connections. The project limits extend from Cortez Road to Manatee Avenue. The existing pipelines within the project limits, constructed in the 1970's, are reaching the end of their useful life and need to be replaced.

FORCE MAIN AND WATER MAIN

When using water for washing, showering or flushing the toilet, the wastewater is delivered via a sewer pipe to a nearby pump station on the island. The pump station conveys the wastewater through a force main pipe that delivers the wastewater to a treatment plant located off the island on Cortez Road. A water main conveys safe drinking water to homes and residences. Methods used to install these pipes include open cut and horizontal directional drilling.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The majority of construction activities are scheduled to take place between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Temporary lane closures and detour routes will be in place as needed.
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained during construction.
- Periodic work will take place overnight to tie-in to main lines.
- Construction activities will take place within Manatee County's right of way.
- Water shut-offs are not scheduled or anticipated during daytime hours; however, if unforeseen pipelines are detected, it may be necessary.

WHAT CAN I DO

- Stay informed. Visit the project website at www.AMlpipeplacement.com.
- Use caution when traveling through the construction zone.
- Obey the speed limit and allow extra time for travel.
- Relocate or cap irrigation lines prior to work taking place in your area.
